Jody Piltz-Seymour, MD, has provided university-level, subspecialty glaucoma care throughout the Philadelphia region for more than 25 years. She enjoys a busy glaucoma referral practice at Valley Eye Professionals/Vantage Eyecare, is an Adjunct Professor at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania, and a staff surgeon and resident instructor at the Wills Eye Hospital Glaucoma Service. She previously served for 15 years as Director of Glaucoma Service and Glaucoma Fellowship Director at the University of Pennsylvania.

As a clinical researcher, Dr Piltz-Seymour served as Principal Investigator for the landmark Ocular Hypertensive Treatment Study from the National Institute of Health, the Collaborative Initial Glaucoma Treatment Trial, and the Low Tension Glaucoma Treatment Study. She has traveled to Ghana, Cameroon, Rwanda, Ethiopia and Vietnam, providing glaucoma medical and surgical training to local ophthalmologists. She serves as a scientific reviewer for many of the major journals of Ophthalmology and has authored over a hundred research papers, book chapters, editorials, and reviews in the field of Glaucoma. Dr. Piltz-Seymour has received the Humanitarian Award from the Pennsylvania Academy of Ophthalmology, Distinguished Educator Award from the American Glaucoma Society, and the Achievement, Senior Achievement and Life Achievement awards from the American Academy of Ophthalmology. She has been recognized as 'Top Doc' and 'Top Doc for Seniors' by Philadelphia Magazine, and "Best Doctors in America" for more than a decade.
